

CODE OF APPLICANT CONDUCT

Applicants agree to conduct themselves in an ethical, moral and Christ-like manner. Applicants understand that if at any time during the adoption process that the applicants' behavior/actions are not consistent with the Christian faith or standards of good parenting, in the sole opinion of Omnah Foundation, Omnah can terminate any agreements or contracts, stop all services, and no refund will be given. Such behaviors, may include, but not limited to: threats of violence, emotional instability, deceit and/or intent to falsify information, hide criminal and child abuse/neglect history, malicious intent, lying, uncontrollable anger, extreme negativity, and/or extreme profanity. Applicants also understand that if they display negative behavior that could be deemed as "unfit," Omnah will report such behavior to the applicant's home study provider, adoption agency/attorney, and/or post placement supervisory agency. Applicants agree to notify Omnah Foundation as soon as possible when any major life event occurs or circumstances change such as separation, divorce, pregnancy, health issue, criminal event/history and/or child abuse/neglect status, significant loss of income, and/or change of residence, etc. Applicants understand that in certain circumstances such as the event of separation/divorce or criminal/child abuse/neglect history status change, or any other significant life change or event that could have adverse effect on the applicants' ability to parent, Omnah may terminate any agreements or contracts and discontinue services. Applicants also understand that if they receive an unfavorable home study, Omnah will terminate any agreements or contracts and discontinue services.
