



PRIVACY STATEMENT

Consent

By applying for a grant from the Foundation, you consent to providing to us your personal information, which we will use, process and store as described herein. In doing so, we will be subject to the relevant data protection laws applicable in the Commonwealth of Virginia and the United States of America, regardless of where you may reside.

Personal or Professional Information Collection and Use

The Foundation will collect and store personally identifiable information, provided in your grant application. This information will primarily be used to consider your application, but may, from time to time, be used to collate applicant information for reports to our donors. We will not otherwise transfer the personally identifiable information you provide to any third party unless otherwise disclosed.

Information Sharing

The Foundation may share your personal information with third parties in the following instances:

- (1) to satisfy applicable law, regulations, legal process or a valid governmental request,
- (2) enforce Terms of Use or Foundation policies;
- (3) detect, prevent or mitigate fraud or security issues; or
- (4) protect against imminent harm to the rights, property or safety of the Foundation, its patrons or the public as required or permitted by law.

Security

We are committed to taking reasonable steps to ensure the security of your information. To prevent unauthorized access, maintain data accuracy, and ensure the appropriate use of information, we have put into place appropriate physical, and electronic procedures to safeguard and secure information we collect from you.

We are not responsible for circumvention of any privacy settings or security measures.
